

Lectures on *Capital* (Vol. 1) and on "Violence and the Making of the Modern State" by Professor Partha Chatterjee :

Prof. Partha Chatterjee will give a series of lectures on select chapters from *Capital* (Vol. 1) and on "Violence and the Making of the Modern State" as part of the MPhil course "Modernity and the Making of the Social."

The first two lectures will discuss Marx's theory of value and the fetishism of commodities based on the first chapter of Marx's *Capital*. Lectures 3 & 4 would discuss Marx's account of the so-called primitive accumulation of capital based on the last chapters of *Capital*, vol. 1 They will focus on recent discussions of primitive accumulation in the context of post-colonial capitalist development. The last two lectures will examine the function of violence (along with security) in the making of the modern state. They will consider the classic justification of state sovereignty by Hobbes and recent attempts to question the efficacy of the state in limiting violence.
