Offers a **two-week** intensive course on **Contemporary Issues in Open Economy**Macroeconomics to be held at the Centre for Studies in Social Sciences, Calcutta (Patuli Campus).

Timeline: September 14 (Thursday) – September 29 (Friday), 2023 Two classes everyday: 11:30 am -1:30 pm and 2:30 pm- 4:30 pm

This course is part of an ongoing effort from the Reserve Bank of India and the RBI Chair for Industrial Economics at the Centre for Studies in Social Sciences, Calcutta to orient and equip banking and finance practitioners, research scholars and advanced students of economics with the state-of-the-art techniques on the aspects of Open Economy Macroeconomics. The proposed training shall allow participants not only to understand the core mechanisms of the subject but also the functioning of the apex banks with special reference to that of the Reserve Bank of India. The knowledge dissemination should allow applications of the techniques predominantly adopted for monetary policies, exchange rate policies, and related decision making at the central bank. This course is an important first step towards understanding complex functioning of the central bank that can facilitate potential careers with the organization as also in scholarly pursuits. The lectures and seminars shall be delivered by renowned economists and professionals.

Additional features:

- Practical training on macro-econometric applications
- Seminars/Special lectures by renowned professionals
- Individual/group presentations by participants on related topics of research
- Possible interactions with officials of the RBI regarding functioning of the apex bank for future career opportunities

Research scholars, post-graduates and professionals with Masters degree/PhD in Economics from the eastern region covering the states of Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha and West Bengal are eligible to apply. The program shall tentatively cater to 30 participants. The language of instruction is English. Participants need to arrange for lodging on their own. A token fee of Rs. 2500/- only (two thousand five hundred only) shall be charged per participant towards cost of communication and study materials.
