**INFORMATION FOR THE CANDIDATES**

- Candidates are required to bring an **official photo ID** (preferably voter I card/ Pan card/ Adhar card/ Passport) without which they will not be allowed to give the interview.
- Candidates (Sl. Nos. 1-17 and 36-52) are advised to report at the Reception **latest** by **9:45 am** on their respective days of interview, candidates (71-85) are advised to report by **10:00 am** and candidates (Sl. Nos. 18-35 and 53-70) are advised to report at the Reception **latest** by **1:30 pm** on the day of the interview.
- All candidates who are called for Interview must ensure that copies of any relevant documents (particularly mark sheets, degree certificates, and proof of any pending examinations/results) which were not submitted at the time of application are submitted to the M. Phil-PhD office latest by 22 June 2018.

- Candidates are required to show their final M.A. grade card/mark sheet. Those who have appeared for their 4<sup>th</sup> semester examination for which the results are awaited, have to present their admit card or a letter regarding completion of their final semester examination from an appropriate authority.
- Candidates who have not appeared for their 4<sup>th</sup> Semester / Part II examination at the time of interview must bring a letter from an appropriate authority indicating that the last date of the examination is no later than **6 July 2018**.
- Candidates who have applied under OBC(A) or OBC(B) categories must submit a recent (dated after June 2017) non-creamy layer certificate latest by 22 June 2018 along with a certificate showing that they belong to OBC(A) or OBC(B) category. In case candidates are not able to obtain the requisite certificates by that date, they are required to submit a self-undertaking at the time of interview that they belong to non-creamy layer of OBC(A) or OBC(B) and that if selected for admission, they would provide the requisite certificate at the time of admission.
